# Ankle Fractures POST OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS Michael F Shepard M.D. (714) 634-4567

## 1. <u>First Post – Operative Day</u>

- A. Continue ice pack every one to two hours while awake.
- **B.** Pain medication as needed.

### 2. <u>Second Post – Operative Day Until Return Visit</u>

- A. Continue ice pack as needed.
- **B.** You will need to keep your op site(s) dry by covering wound with a plastic bag when taking a shower.
- C. You may not place any weight on your operated extremity. Use your crutches for movement and balance.
- **D.** You must wear your splint at all times.

### NO WEIGHT BEARING ON THE OPERATED SIDE

- 3. <u>Suture Removal</u>
  - A. Your sutures need to be removed 7-10 days from surgery at your first post op visit. Rehab should start after your first visit.

#### **For Return Appointments**

- 4. Your 1<sup>st</sup> post-op visit will need to be scheduled for 7 days after surgery.
- 5. If you have any problems or questions please call our office at (714) 634-4567 during offices hours 8:00-5:00. If you have a problem after hours the answering service will contact Dr. Shepard.
- 6. Any activity that requires precise thinking and accuracy must be avoided for the first twelve hours after surgery and while taking pain medication, which includes operating machinery and/or driving a vehicle.
